Beth will share her story and lead us through a project to decorate rocks to give to cancer patients.

Beth Gleason has been a Senior IT Delivery and Project Manager for over 25 years. She has run statewide and global projects at Electronic Data Systems, General Motors, Oakland County, and the State of Michigan.

In 2016, she went on her first cancer walk and became involved in the Macomb/Oakland County Making Strides Against Breast Cancer planning committees that is sponsored by the American Cancer Society (ACS).

In 2017, she and her daughters created a volunteer organization under ACS called Youth Against Cancer. As the Youth Coordinator, Beth has used her leadership and project management skills to recruit youth to the organization for fundraising events, to join the walk planning committee, and began a rock painting program that has delivered over 6000 cancer care rocks to cancer patients, survivors, and their families.

She also utilizes the organization to mentor youth to build leadership skills and gain volunteer hours which has led the youth volunteers to obtain top scholarships at universities, win national awards, and gain entry to medical school. The organization involves over 30 high schools, universities, and hospitals and continues to grow throughout the state.
